# Behaviour system

Consequence 1	Reminded of behaviour (verbally and/or 'the look') is preventing an excellent lesson from taking place.
Consequence 2	Formal warning that behaviour is preventing an excellent lesson from taking place.
Consequence 3	Moved to a designated seat or area in the classroom.
Consequence 4*	Moved to another classroom and details entered in to the schools behaviour log. Parents informed.
Consequence 5*	'Time Out'. Parents informed
Consequence 6*	Exclusion and meeting with parents

# Rewards system

Reward 1	Verbal praise and feedback.
Reward 2	Written feedback in books/diaries.
Reward 3	Stickers/Class Dojo's.
Reward 4	Visiting Headteacher with good news and/or good work.
Reward 5	Star of the Week.
Reward 6	Extra play.

# Mathematics

- Secure place value & rounding to 10,000,000, including negatives
- All written methods, including long division
- Use order of operations
- Identify factors, multiples & primes
- Solve multi-step number problems
- Counting (positive and negative numbers) and Partitioning (including millions, tenths and hundredths)

Confidently use a range of measures & conversions

- Calculate area of triangles / parallelograms
- Use area & volume formulas
- Classify shapes by properties
- Know and use angle rules
- Translate & reflect shapes, using all four quadrants

Data

- Use pie charts
- Calculate mean averages

Compare & simplify fractions

- Use equivalents to add fractions
- Multiply simple fractions
- Divide fractions by whole numbers
- Solve problems using decimals & percentages
- Use written division up to 2dp
- Introduce ratio & proportion

# English

- Reading and writing
- Read a broad range of genres
  - Support inferences with evidence
  - Summarising key points from texts
  - Discuss use of language, inc. figurative
  - Use knowledge of morphology & etymology in spelling
  - Develop legible personal handwriting style
  - Plan writing to suit audience & purpose; use models of writing

## Grammar

- Use the passive voice for purpose
- Use full punctuation
- Use language of subject/object

## Speaking & Listening

- Use questions to build knowledge
- Articulate arguments & opinions

- We cover three themes over the year (Benin, Then and Now, Move it! And Mountains and Coasts!).
