- TIMES TABLES (12 X 12)
- Weekly tables tests- minimum of $60 \%$ or re test the following day
- Problem Solving and reasoning.
- Challenges - daily
- Concrete materials to support all learners

- Three themes covered the year
- Each theme has a specific focus. This term we will be focusing on the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings, we will also learning about Rivers and Mountains and finally, the Egyptians.
