# Behaviour

- The school has a clear behaviour policy that is linked to a positive discipline strategy. Children will always be rewarded for good behaviour with:

  - Extra Play
  - WOW moments



## Springcroft Primary School Consequence Ladder

Consequence 1	Reminded of behaviour (verbally and/or 'the look') is preventing an excellent lesson from taking place.
Consequence 2	Formal warning that behaviour is preventing an excellent lesson from taking place.
Consequence 3	Moved to a designated seat or area in the classroom.
Consequence 4*	Moved to another classroom and details entered in to the schools behaviour log. Parents informed.
Consequence 5 *	'Time Out'. Parents informed
Consequence 6 *	Exclusion and meeting with parents



# Uniform



Children must wear the correct uniform to school.

- white shirt/white polo shirt (tie if wanted)
- Grey / black trousers/pinafore/skirt
- Navy jumper or cardigan (does not have to have the logo on)
- Black shoes not trainers
- Long hair tied up
