- Please read with your child and sign their diary (3 x per week please).

- Spellings are given out every Monday (this will commence in Autumn Term 2).
- Spelling test takes place the following Monday.
- Homework will be set on Tuesdays in their homework book. Please return on a Monday.

Behaviour

- The school has a clear behaviour policy that is linked to a positive discipline strategy. Children will always be rewarded for good behaviour with:
 - Verbal praise/feedback
 - Stickers/Dojos
 - Visit to the Headteacher
 - Star of the week
 - Extra Play



Reward 1	Verbal praise and feedback.
Reward 2	Written feedback in books/diaries.
Reward 3	Stickers/Class Dojo's.
Reward 4	Visiting Headteacher with good news and/or good work.
Reward 5	Star of the Week.
Reward 6	Extra play.

Springcroft Primary School Consequence Ladder

Consequence 1	Reminded of behaviour (verbally and/or 'the look') is preventing an excellent lesson from taking place.
Consequence 2	Formal warning that behaviour is preventing an excellent lesson from taking place.
Consequence 3	Moved to a designated seat or area in the classroom.
Consequence 4*	Moved to another classroom and details entered in to the schools behaviour log. Parents informed.
Consequence 5 *	'Time Out'. Parents informed
Consequence 6 *	Exclusion and meeting with parents

Uniform



Children must wear the correct uniform to school.

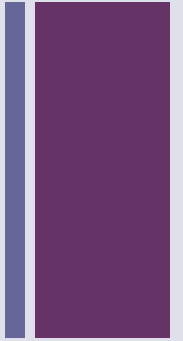
- white shirt/white polo shirt (tie if wanted)
- Grey / black trousers/pinafore/skirt
- Navy jumper or cardigan (does not have to have the logo on)
- Black shoes not trainers
- Long hair tied up

- If children are not wearing the correct uniform please let us know the reason.
- The only jewellery allowed in school is a watch and stud earrings and these must be removed by the child or yourself before PE.
- Please ensure labels are on all items of uniform including shoes, coats and PE kit.

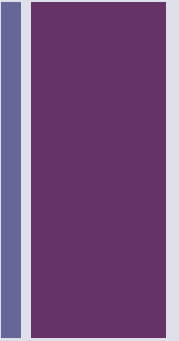
